How does it work?		Students are eligible to transfer to a school outside their designated attendance zone, as long as the designated school is more than four years old and has permanent classroom space available with consideration of projected enrollment, maximum class size and available teachers.	Eligible special needs students can request a transfer under the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship (GSNS).
